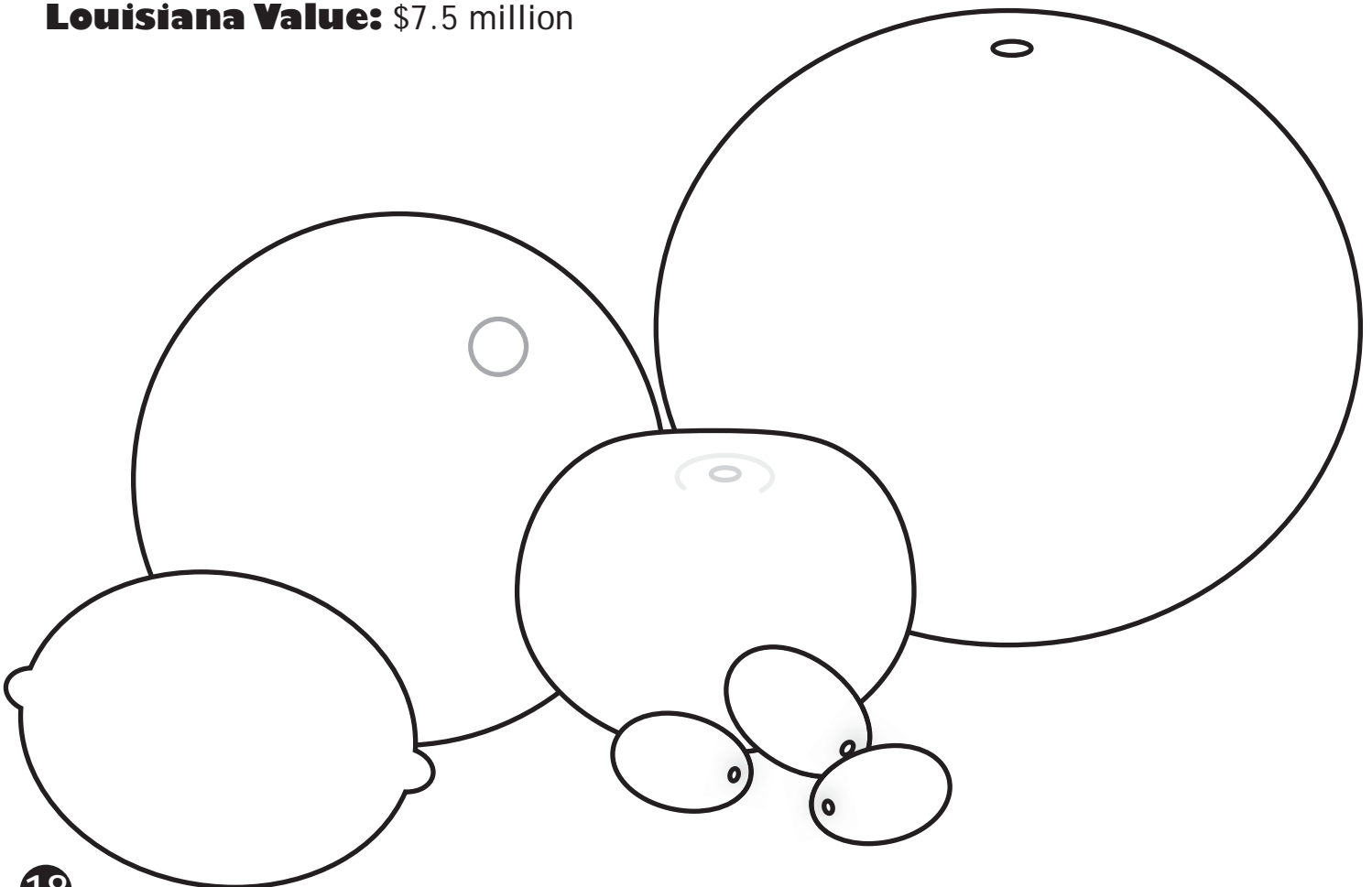


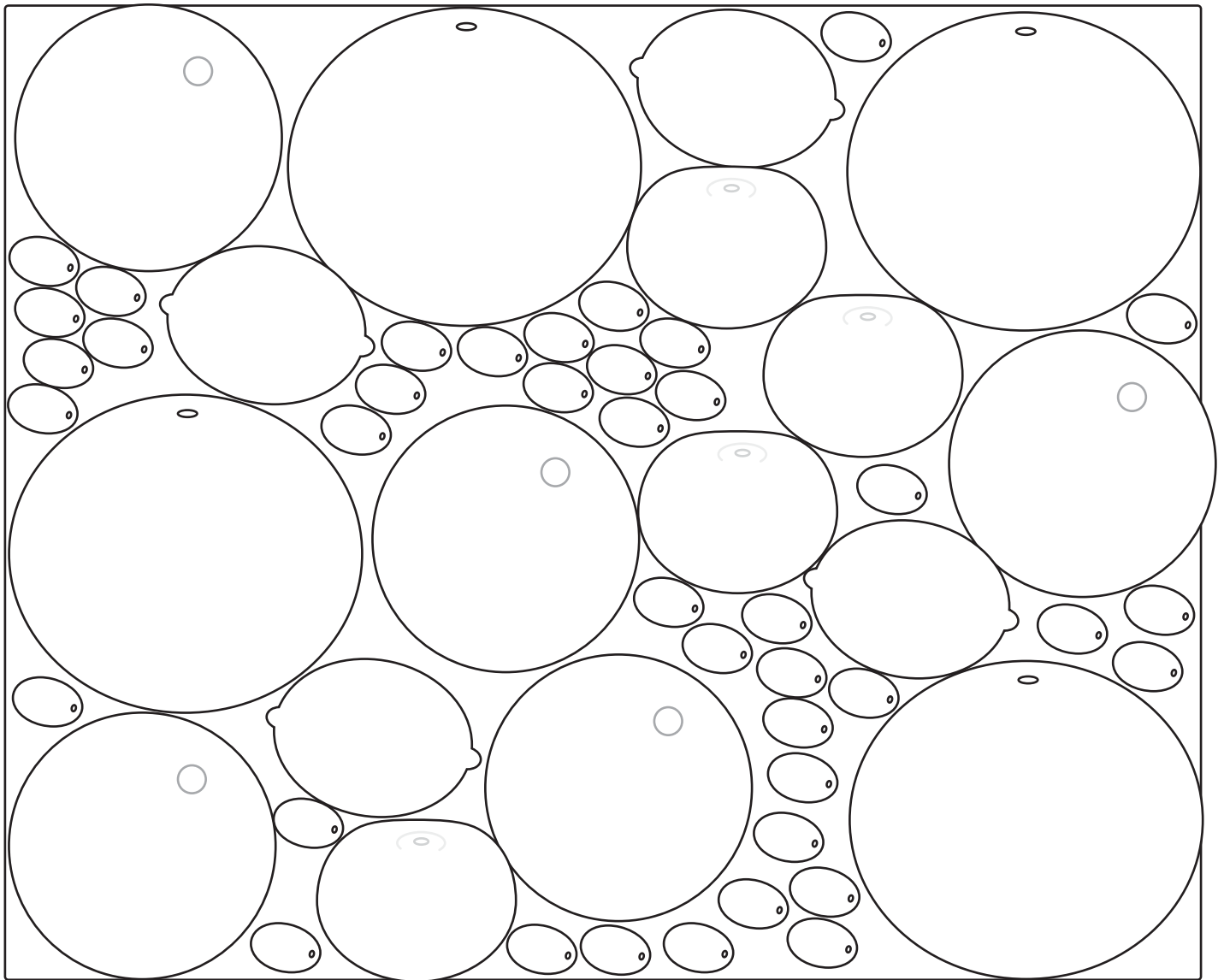
CITRUS

Good for You: Citrus is a good source of vitamin C.

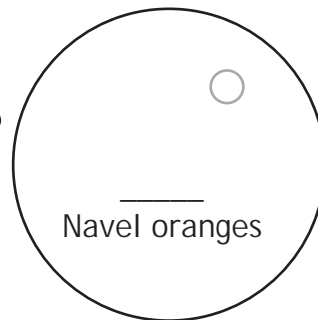
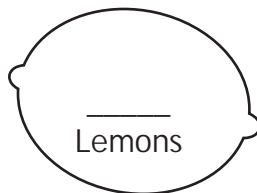
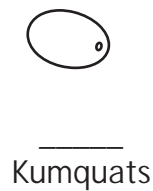
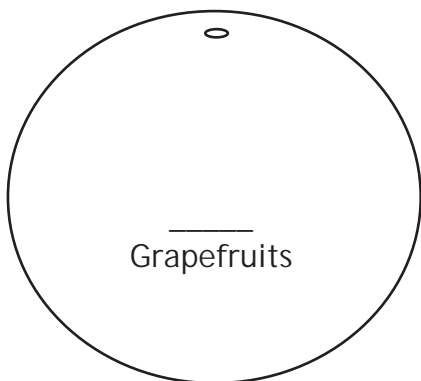
